

## Board Bio – Lavina Murray

Lavina resides in Darwin, having moved gradually north from Tenant Creek which is a small town about 3 and half hours' drive north of Alice Springs. Her father's family are from the Barkly Tablelands and her mother's side is from around the Tennant Creek area.



Her employment history has been solely based around working for aboriginal organisations and with aboriginal people in general, more recently around providing further education on the criminal justice system of the NT. Lavina has been employed by what was formally known as the Katherine Regional Aboriginal Legal Aid Service (KRALAS) and North Australian Aboriginal Justice Agency (NAAJA) as it's now known for approximately 16 years. Her role within the organisation is the Prison-based Throughcare Support Officer and she is based within the Darwin Correctional Centre (Berrimah Prison).

Lavina's involvement with Tranby commenced in 2009 when she participated in the Field Officers Course and following completion, she was encouraged to then apply for the National Indigenous Legal Advocacy Course 2010/2011. Lavina has also since studied the Governance Course in 2013.

Lavina feels that Tranby is a fantastic learning environment, with staff who fully encourage further personal development. She has remained a strong supporter for Tranby and requests that you consider her application as a Director of Tranby.
